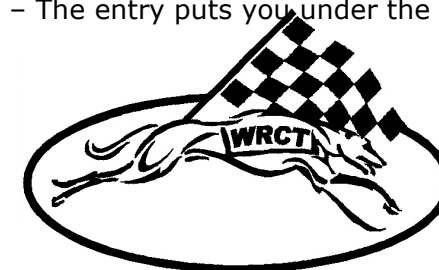

Starting time:	9:00
Presentation of the dogs, veterinary check:	Saturday and Sunday 7:30 – 8:30, Saturday afternoon for the dogs starting on Sunday
Coursing Director:	Jörg Millert
Distance:	800-900 m for the large breeds und about 700 m for the small breeds
Lure technique:	Lure pulled over pulleys
Coursing track:	Snow, well prepared area, mainly even
Type of competition:	According to FCI and ÖKV Regulations. The dog must have a valid FCI racing or coursing licence. The use of a muzzle is not compulsory for Italian Greyhounds.
CCLA Regulations:	Acc. to § 5 of the ÖKV –Windhunde Coursingsportordnung
CACIL Regulations:	Acc. to § 5 of the FCI Regulations
Prizes:	Trophys for the 1 st to 3 rd place
Prize-giving ceremony:	About 45 minutes after the last course.
Entry fee:	€ 30 per dog, the 2 nd and following dogs of the same owner € 25 per dog - Box office – The entry puts you under the obligation to pay the fee.
Entry closing date:	21 January 2011, or when the the maximum entry is reached.

<p>At least six dogs per breed are at the start</p> <p>If your dog is to compete for the CACIL, please:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) mark it on the entry form2) include a proof of the qualification from a dog show – the dog must have earned a grading not lower than "very good" in junior (over 15 months) – open – intermediate – working or champion class at an international show under the patronage of FCI.	<p>If there are fewer than six dogs per breed at the start, the CCLA can be awarded.</p> <p>If your dog is to compete for the CCLA, please:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) mark it on the entry form2) include a proof of the qualification from a dog show – the dog must have earned two gradings not lower than "very good" in junior (over 15 months) – open – intermediate – working or champion class at a national or international ÖKV show (in Austria) or at the national ÖKWZR Cubwinner (in Austria).
